# EASI Standard Document Versioning Recommendations

#### EASI Standard Document Versioning Recommendations:

Adopt a release number comprised of two components, broken down as follows:

- first number: major release
- second number: minor release
- Examples include 3.0, 3.2, 2.1, 4.5, etc.
- Beta releases are denoted by adding "B-Beta version number" after the release number.
- Examples include 3.0B-1, 2.4B-2, etc.
- A <u>major release</u> is warranted when substantive changes are made to an EASI Document that affect the file layout, or when a significant number of smaller enhancements are made such that a major release would be more appropriate than a minor release. A major release must be approved by a simple majority of EASI Organization voting members.
- A <u>minor release</u> is warranted when changes are made that do not affect the file layout and are more administrative in nature. A minor release must be approved by a simple majority of EASI Organization Steering Committee members.

#### Field Definition Change

- Required Field Definition Change Minor Release
- Optional Field Definition Change Minor Release

## Example Change

- Required Example Change Minor Release
- Optional Example Change Minor Release

## **Required/Optional Change**

- Change from Required to Optional Major Release
- Change from Optional to Required Major Release



#### Field Format Change

- Required Field Format Change Major Release
- Optional Field Format Change Major Release

#### Field Size Change

- Required Field Size Change Major Release
- Optional Field Size Change Major Release

**Comments Change** - Minor Release

Field Addition - Major Release

Field Removal - Major Release

**Corrections to Known Errors** – Minor Release
