SFTP Communication

EASI Standards recommends that SFTP be used for all communications.

Recommendation

In a modern technical business climate where cyber security and digital asset protection are at the forefront of business decisions, it's important that all data is secure, and this includes file transfer and data sharing systems. As a result, the EASI Standards Group is strongly recommending that all EASI communications be moved to SSH File Transfer Protocol, or Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP). This time-tested standard technology employs SSH (Secure Shell) to provide encryption of communications between the FTP server and client including both authentication and message traffic. SFTP provides the highest level of protection for data in transit and should be considered without delay.

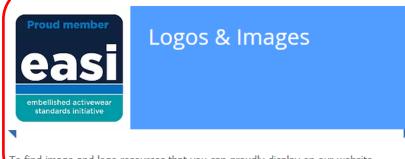

Packing Slip

EASI Standards recommends that a packing slip be included with all shipments specifically drop ship purchase orders (EASI Standards 940).

Purpose

The packing slip is designed to help identify when a shipment is received. By recommending a standardized packing slip, this will help the customer receive a packing list that is consistent with the same information each time a shipment is received. The intention of the packing slip is to help the end customer identify what is in a shipment, who the shipment is from, and what purchase order the shipment is for.

Key Elements

We recommend the packing slip including the following information:

- Ship From Address (The ship from address is the physical address where customer shipments are sent from)
- Ship to Address (The ship-to address is the physical address where customer shipments are sent to).
- Contact name (The appropriate person where a shipment should be sent to in relation to a business)
- Customer PO number (The number that was assigned to the purchase order by the customer). This is Customer PO Number Field#9 on EASI 940 version 4.0. This is listed as an Optional Field.
- Unit of Measure
- Carton Count
- Quantity

EASI Standards recommends that delivery addresses be validated by the purchaser.

Recommendation

It is the EASI Standards Group's recommendation that the Purchaser be responsible for providing accurate and deliverable ship to address information within the 850/940 Purchase Orders transmitted to the Wholesaler/Seller, and third party address validation services be utilized by the Purchaser to ensure deliverable addresses are provided to the Wholesaler/Shipper.

This recommendation affects the following standards:

850 Purchase Order

940 Direct Ship PO

Address Validation – 850/940

- · Shipping period and delivery instructions

New Business - Duplicate GTINs

Duplicate GTINs

- Issue: Duplicate GTINs provided within a single file or loop.
 - Example: 852 POS GTIN appearing more than once within a single file (within a single store id)
- Standards do not always specify if GTIN can be repeated
- Common Issue?
- Should the standards be reviewed and usage comments added where appropriate?

- 180 Single GTIN may only appear once in each Detail Loop
- 181 Single GTIN may only appear once in each Detail Loop

Standardized Price List

- Issue getting consistent price lists from vendors
- Options:
 - Suggested Standardized Price List Format
 - Change the 832 PDD File Item Price to be a required field
 - Create a new EASI document which essential would be a price list

888 Item Maintenance

- Do we need a method to communicate product changes?
 - Case Qty, Weights, Volume
- Companion/Mirror to 832 PDD File
